Ascend SE. slope 475. ft. to

51.60 Top of ridge, bears N and S; descend W slope 315 ft. to

59.45 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course S; ascend SE slope 215 ft. to

64.55 Top of ridge, bears N and S; descend W slope 285 ft. to

72.30 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course S; ascend SE slope 110 ft. to

74.70 Top of spur, slopes SE; descend along S slope 160 ft. to

80.65 Stream, 4 lks. wide, course SE; ascend E slope 30 ft. to

82.39 The cor. of Secs. 11 and 14, on E bdy. of Sec. 10.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow sandy loam; 1st rate.

Timber, Alder, Maple, Fir, Hemlock and Cedar.

Undergrowth, Huckleberry, Rhododendron, Vinemaple,
Salmonberry and Salal.

From the cor. of Secs. 11 and 14 North on a blank line
and at 72.03 chs. intersect random line projected east
from the cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10; at 73.89 chs.
east of said cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

From the cor. of Secs. 11 and 14, on the E bdy. of
Sec. 10.

North, bet. Secs. 10 and 11.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth, descending along E slope 25 ft. to

1.55 Stream, 4 lks. wide, course SE; ascend along W slope
455 ft. to ridge.

7.75 Draw, course SW.

11.95 Gulch, course SW.

15.55 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course SW; ascend SW slope.

22.00 Top of ridge, bears E and W; descend NW slope 145 ft.
