- 60.90 Ravine, course SW; continue descent 35 ft. to  
 61.90 Bottom of descent; ascend 70 ft. to  
 68.80 Top of ascent on S slope; descend broken SW slope 160  
 ft. to  
 74.30 (A point S of the old cor. of Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21).  
 Set a hard sandstone, 15x10x4 ins. 10 ins. in the ground,  
 for cor. of Secs. 20 and 21, marked with 4 notches on
