CHAINS

- 41.70 Ascend NE slope 135 ft. to
- 46.75 Top of ridge, bears NW and SE; descend SW slope 60 ft. to
- 49.65 Foot of descent; ascend SE slope 15 ft. to
- 53.60 Top of same ridge, bears N.75°E., and S.75°W; descend along N slope 20 ft. to
- 60.70 Foot of descent; ascend NE slope 170 ft. to
- 62.80 Top of same ridge, bears NW and SE; along S slope.
- 66.80 Same ridge, bears NE and N.85°W., descend SW slope 30 ft. to
- 70.50 Foot of descent; ascend SE slope 45 ft. to
- 72.60 Top of spur, slopes S; descend along S slope 60 ft. to
- 77.00 Foot of descent; ascend along S slope 55 ft. to corner.
- 79.30 Ascend SE slope.

Undergrowth, Huckleberry, Fern, Salal, Vinemaple, Rhododendron, Lilac and Manzanita.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. corner.
- 88.55 Intersect the S bdy. of the Tp., 7 lks. W of the corner of Secs. 33 and 34.
Thence
North, on a true line, bet. Secs. 33 and 34.
Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, ascending SW slope 155 ft. to
- 4.05 Top of ridge, bears NW and SE; along E slope.
- 8.20 Top of spur, slopes E; descend NE slope 145 ft. to
- 13.80 Draw, course NE; thence along E. slope.
- 16.25 Descend N slope 225 ft. to
- 21.85 Ravine, course E; ascend S slope 440 ft. to
