## CHAINS

- 57.15 Top of ridge, bears SE and NW; descend NE slope 765 ft. to creek.
- 59.30 Drain, course NE.
- 63.60 Drain, course NE.
- 68.50 Drain, course NE.
- 76.00 Top of spur, slopes NE; descend N slope.
- 79.40 Harvey Creek, 10 lks. wide, course W; ascend SW slope 130 ft. to
- 83.50 Top of ascent; thence along W slope.
- 85.50 Ravine, course SW; ascend SE slope 115 ft. to
- 88.50 The corner of Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, shallow rocky sandy loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.  
Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Maple and Alder.  
Undergrowth, Rhododendron, Salmonberry, Huckleberry, Vinemaple, Salal and Fern.
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- From the cor. of Secs. 20 and 21, on the N bdy. of Sec. 28.  
North, on a random line, bet. Secs. 20 and 21.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. corner.
- 78.42 Intersect E and W line, at the old corner of Secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, hereafter described.  
Thence  
South, on a true line, bet. Secs. 20 and 21.  
Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, ascending N slope 120 ft. to
- 4.15 Top of spur, slopes NW; descend 25 ft. along W slope to
- 8.50 Bottom of descent; ascend along W slope 175 ft. to
- 16.15 Top of spur, slopes SW; descend S slope 300 ft. to
- 23.80 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course W; ascend along W slope 110 ft. to
- 25.80 Top of spur, slopes SW; descend 10 ft. to
- 27.00 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NW; ascend 165 ft. to
