Timber, Alder, Maple, Fir, Cedar and Hemlock.

Undergrowth, Salmonberry, Huckleberry, Vinemaple, Salal and Fern.

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- N.87*33'E., resurveying the line bet. Secs. 4 and 9.
Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, descending NE slope 15 ft. to
- 1.30 Wasson Creek, 20 lks. wide, course NW; thence over creek bottom.
- 14.65 Same creek, 30 lks. wide, course SW.
- 17.70 Same creek, 30 lks. wide, course NW; ascend SW slope 550 ft. to
- 40.89 Intersect point for old $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., located by reference to the old bearing trees. At the exact cor. point set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., with brass cap marked

- From this $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.
- S.88*26'E., resurveying the line bet. Secs. 4 and 9.
Continue ascent on NW slope 95 ft. to
- 2.80 Top of spur, slopes N; descend NE slope 125 ft. to
- 10.60 Ravine, course N; ascend NW slope 305 ft. to
- 17.15 Top of spur, slopes N; descend NE slope 55 ft. to
- 19.45 Ravine, course N; ascend SW slope 155 ft. to
- 22.90 Top of spur, slopes NW; descend NE slope 345 ft. to
- 31.50 Canyon, course NW; ascend W slope 175 ft. to
- 36.55 Top of spur, slopes NW; continue ascent along N slope 60 ft. to
