A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.5 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 43 lks. dist.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.63\*E., 17 lks. dist.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.85\*W., 62 lks. dist.

S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, soil, 3rd rate.
