36.25	Set meander post on left bank, from which A bearberry, 6 ins. diam., bears S.49*W., 64 lks. dist. A vine maple, 4 ins. diam., bears S.82*E., 09 lks. dist.
40.00	Set post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which A spruce, 12 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 31 lks. dist. A cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 48 lks. dist.
80.00	Set stone 12x10x5 for cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 30 lks. dist. Land, rough and broken. Soil 1st rate. Timber, fir, spruce, hemlock, maple and cedar. Dense undergrowth of vine maple and spruce. <p style="text-align: right;">Jan. 20.</p>
40.00	West, on a random line bet. secs. 2 and 11. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.76	Intersect N. and S. line 35 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, from which cor. I run S.89*45'E. on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 11.
40.38	Set post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which A maple, 30 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 19 lks. dist. A spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears N.18*E., 6 lks. dist.
80.76	The cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12. Land, rough and broken along base of rough and rugged mountains. Soil, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, spruce and hemlock. Undergrowth, hemlock and spruce.
