General Description.

The land in this Tp. is of but little value, except on
 the bottom along Smiths River and Frarys and Otter
 Creek. The mountains in the North, East and Southern
 portions are very abrupt and of no value for farming,
 grazing or timber. The soil along the bottoms is 1st
 rate.

There are settlers on the River and on the creeks. I
 have surveyed all the land now claimed or that will
 be; although some of the lines are surveyed in an
 irregular way, it is the best I could do where I was
 compelled to commence at the Meridian on the W. and
 follow up the River bottom, as it is impracticable to
 survey the mountains.
