marked T 21 S R 11 W S 13 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 21*W., 45 lks. dist.
marked T 21 S R 11 W S 24 B T.

Land, mountainous. 80.00 chs.

Soil, gravelly and stoney; 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, alder, maple, hemlock, heavily tim-
bered.

Dense undergrowth of salmon, huckle, salal and thimble-
berries, vinemaples and small firs; 80.00 chs.

July 9, 1891.

I am entering burnt timber country, with rocky canyons
and ridges.

South, on E. bdy. of sec. 24.

Va.19*48'E.

Steep descent.

1.50 Same branch, 3 lks. wide, course W., begin steep ascent -60

2.75 Leave green fir timber, ascend burns W. slope of spur.

Va.20*45'E.

27.50 Top of ridge, dividing waters, flowing into Murphy +750
Creek, from those into Harvey Creek; begin descent of
S. slope; bears NW. and SE.

31.25 A canyon, course E; begin ascent -125

36.50 Top of spur, bears E. and W.; descend W. slope. +120

40.00 Set a sandstone 12x8x6 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for ¼ -40
sec. cor. marked ¼ on W. face, and raised a mound of
stone, 1½ ft. high, 2 ft. base, alongside. Pits im-
practicable.

42.00 A canyon, course E; begin steep ascent. -50

55.00 Top of spur, bears E. and W; begin descent. +60

62.50 A canyon with a stream; 5 lks. wide, course N.60*E; -75
begin ascent.
