CHAINS

49.75	A canyon, course S.30*E.	-150
56.50	Top of spur, bears SW. and NE., descend.	+130
73.00	A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S; thence along SW. slope near foot of hill, through green fir timber.	-250
80.25	Enter bottom bears N.60*W. and S.60*E.	
84.29	Right bank of Umpqua River; set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for meander cor. to fractional secs. 36 and 1, marked M C on W., T 22 S S 1 on S., T 21 S S 36 on N., R 11 W on E sides, from which A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears N.73*W., 66 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 36 M C B T. A dble. spruce, 24 ins. diam., bears N.83*E., 34 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 36 MC B T. No trees S. of line; this post stands 507 lks. E. and 126 lks. S. of meander cor. bet. fractional secs. 35 and 36, which is gone; but I mark a willow, 4 ins. diam., grown up since, for meander cor; M C on S. face, S. 35 on W. face T 21 S on N. face, R 11 W S 36 on E. face, from which A willow, 6 ins. diam., bears N.32*E., 26 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 36 M C B T. A willow, 6 ins. diam., bears N.10*W., 24 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 35 M C B T. Land, mountainous. 80.25 chs. Soil, rocky except W. 5 chs., loam; 3rd and 1st rate. Timber, scattering fir, alder, spruce, maple, Dense undergrowth of salmon, huckle and blackberries, vinemaples, small willows; 84.29 chs.
