

Subdivisions of T. 21 S., R. 11 W.

CHAINS

Fire having destroyed the cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

I begin at the meander cor. to fractional secs. 2 and 3 on the left bank of Smiths river. I replace the cor. by setting a sandstone 8x8x8 ins., 6 ins. in the ground marked M C on N. face, from which

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N.55*E., 5 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 2 M C B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.15*W., 26 lks. dist. marked T 21 S R 11 W S 3 M C B T.

Thence I run

S.0*2'E. bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Va.19*40'E.

Begin ascent of SE. slope

25.17	Set a sandstone, 24x18x4 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11 marked 5 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, and raised a mound of stone 1½ ft. high, 2 ft. base alongside; pits impracticable.	+75
	Land, mountainous. 25.17 chs.	
	Soil, gravelly and stony; 3rd and 4th rate.	
	Heavily timbered by fir, alder, maple.	
	Dense undergrowth of salmon and thimbleberries and vine-maples. 25.17 chs.
