Soil, gravelly and rocky; 3rd and 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, alder, cedar, hemlock, cherry maple.

Dense undergrowth of salmon, salal, huckle and thimbleberries, vinemaple. 80.00 chs.

N.89*57'E. on random line bet. secs. 23, and 14.

Va.20*10'E.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.80 Intersect N. and S. line, 50 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Thence I run

N.89*42'W. on true line bet. secs. 14 and 23.

Va.20*41'E.

14.20 A canyon, course SW., ascend

21.50 Top of spur, bears SW. and NE.

33.40 A branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.

40.40 Set a sandstone 9x8x7 ins., 6 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high and 2 ft. base alongside; pits impracticable.

47.25 Top of spur bears S.30'E. and N.30'W.
