40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.	
80.44	Intersect N. and S. line, 36 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 25 and 26.	
	North, 89*48'W. on true line on South bdy. of sec. 26. Va.20*11'E.
