- 58.50 Begin ascent of steep burnt N slope, covered densely
by green young cherry trees.
- 61.00 Enter burnt timber.
- 63.10 A cliff, 8 ft. high.
- 63.50 As the line passes over bare bedrock, to smooth and
steep for secure footing, I go
S.14*W., 13.00 chs. to top of ridge, bears E and W +400
thence descend.
S.33½*E., 4.10 chs.
