62.00	Leave green timber, enter burnt.	
68.50	Top of dividing ridge, bears NW and SE; begin steep descent.	+250
79.60	The cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30. Land, mountainous. 79.60 chs. Soil, gravelly and 3d rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, alder, hemlock, maple, cherry. Dense undergrowth of salmon, salal, thimbleberries, vine maple, small firs and alders. 79.60 chs.
