76.75	A canyon, course S; begin ascent.	-300
79.20	The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30. Land, mountainous. 79.20 chs. Soil, gravelly and rocky. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, spruce, hemlock, alder, maple, cherry. Dense undergrowth of salmon, salal and thimbleberries, vine maples. 79.20 chs.
