1.00	A gulch, course SW; begin ascent.	-50
4.00	Top of spur, bears N and S; descend.	+80
9.50	A canyon, course S.	-60
12.50	Top of ascent.	+80
17.75	Enter bottom, a dry branch, course N.75*W., bottom bears SE and NW.	
22.50	Leave bottom; ascend N slope covered by small alders and cherries.	
25.00	a cleared small bottom N about 2.50 chs.	
39.64	Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears S.14*E., 50 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. 69.75	A creek, course NW., 8 lks. wide.	
70.00	Leave bottom, begin ascent.	
72.75	Top of spur, bears N and S; descend.	+75
74.50	A canyon, course N; ascend.	-50
77.50	Top of spur, bears N and S; descend W slope through burnt cherries and alders.	+60
79.28	The cor. to secs. 29 and 30. Land, mountainous, except about 10 chs. W of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, which are level; 70.33 chs. mountainous.	-80
