24.00	A canon, course SW; begin ascent of steep rocky S slope.	-120
48.75	Top of ridge, dividing the waters running direct into the Umpqua, from those running into Butler creek.	+500
57.00	A canyon and branch, 2 lks. wide, course W; head of branch is probably 10 chs. E of here.	
57.64	Intersect S bdy. of sec. 28, 18.30 chs. W of cor. to secs. 27 and 28.	
	Set a sandstone, 14x11x4 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. to secs. 33 and 34, marked C C with 1 notch on S and 3 notches on E edges, and raised a mound of stone, 1½ ft. high and 2 ft. base alongside; pits impracticable.	
	Land, mountainous. 57.64 chs.	
	Soil, first S 15.00 chs. gravelly and 3d rate, balance stony and 4th rate.
