| 1.50 | Top of spur, bears E and W; begin descent of N slope. | +75 |

| 12.80 | A canyon, course W; ascend N slope. | -80 |
| 19.75 | Dividing ridge, ascend along SE slope. | +280 |
| 24.00 | Begin to descend. | |
| 26.75 | Descend abruptly down a gulch. | -40 |
| 33.00 | Leave gulch, ascend W slope. | -200 |
