36.84	Set meander post, from which A boxwood, 4 ins. diam., bears N.25°W., 30 lks. dist. No tree near S. of line.
40.00	Set qr. sec. post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions. October 7, 1857.
55.50	Right bank of Schofield River. Set post, from which A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears N.22°E., 279 lks. dist. No tree S. of line. There are to be so many cors. hereabouts the trench is omitted in this place. Across in line, Base S. 200 lks. Angle opposite, 19° dist. 580 lks.
61.30	Set post from which A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears S.9°E., 206 lks. dist. No tree N. of line. Trench omitted.
73.64	To left bank of Schofield River. Set meander post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions. Across in line, Base S.27°E., 180 lks. dist. Angle opposite, 16° dist. 476 lks.
78.40	To right bank, set post from which A crab, 6 ins. diam., bears N.4°W., 56 lks. dist. A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears S.75°E., 56 lks. dist.
80.00	Set post cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, from which A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears S.75°W., 36 lks. dist. A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears N.20°W., 65 lks. dist. A spruce, 12 ins. diam., bears N.8°E., 102 lks. dist. A spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears S.80°E., 458 lks. dist.
