40.00	Set qr. sec. post, from which A maple, 18 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 6 lks. dist. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 32 lks. dist. Base, North 72 lks. Angle opposite, 10½*. Distance, 3.88 chs.

45.00	Ridge, course S.
47.00	Ridge, course S.
57.00	Ridge, course S.
60.00	Brushy ravine. Base, N. 1.04 lks. Angle opposite, 14* Distance, 4.17 chs.
64.17	To object
77.50	Stream 3 lks. wide, course S.
80.00	Set post, cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, as noted in book of field notes of Tp. lines. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, spruce and maple. Undergrowth, brier, gooseberry, sallow, elder, whortle- berry, salmon berry, hazel, vine-maple, laurel, and bluewood.

5.80	Set meander post on S. side of Black's Island, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per in- structions.
13.70	N. side of Black's Island, set post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions. Across to Goose Island in line. Base, W. 2.50 chs., angle opposite, 16 ¾*. Distance, 8.31 chs.
22.01	Set post on S. side of Goose Island, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions.
25.13	Leave Island; set post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions. On main land. Base, E. 1.50 chs; angle opposite, 22½*; distance, 3.67 chs.
