- 5.60 Leave river, set post on left bank, from which
 A spruce, 6 ins. diam., bears S.73 W., 18 lks. dist.
 A red willow, 4 ins. diam., bears N.38*W., 110 lks. dist.
- 11.25 To right bank of side channel, set post, from which
 A crab, 5 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 6 lks. dist.
 A crab, 5 ins. diam., N.6*W., 36 lks. dist.
 Across in line, Base, N. 30 lks., angle 11*
 Distance, 1.55 chs.
- 12.80 Set post on left bank, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions.
- 23.50 Leave marsh.
- 40.00 Set qr. sec. post, from which
 A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.37*E., 74 lks. dist.
 A willow, 12 ins. diam., bears S.57*E., 73 lks. dist.
- 45.00 Ridge, course N and S.
- 60.50 Stream 5 lks. wide, course N.
- 70.00 Ridge, course N & S.
- 80.00 Set sec. cor. as noted in field Book of Town Lines.
 Land, mountainous.
 Soil, 3rd rate.
 Timber, fir and spruce.
 Undergrowth, Brier, sallal and salmon berry.

 A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears N.6 3/4*E., 450 lks. dist.
 A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears N.1*W., 417 lks. dist.
