CHAINS	
	A crab, 4 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 57 lks. dist.
40.00	Set qr. sec. post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions.
46.00	Slough 50 lks. wide, course SW.
54.00	To slough near where it reaches the left bank of Umpqua River. Set post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench as per instructions, set up flag. Regained line on Bolon's Island. Base, N. 8.50 chs. West 6.20 chs., flag bears S.9½*E. Distance over, 28.57 chs.
80.00	Cor of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35 is in Umpqua River. Land, level; marsh subject to inundation of 1 ft. depth at highest winter tides, but usually dry. Luxuriant growth of grass and a fair crop of crab-apples. October 25, 1857.
	East, on true line bet. secs. 26 and 35. Begin N. 2.57 chs. from sec. cor. S.40*E., 2.30 chs. S.60*E., 1.62 chs.
2.88	Set meander post, from which A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.59*W., 34 lks. dist. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.49*E., 34 lks. dist.
7.00	Summit of hill.
25.00	Stream 1 lk. wide, course N.
27.50	Stream 1 lk. wide, course N.
40.00	Set qr. sec. post, from which A yellow-wood, 5 ins. diam., bears N.70*W., 12 lks. dist. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.89*E., 100 lks. dist.
41.00	Ridge, course NE.
42.00	Top of Bluff, Base N. 42 lks. Angle opposite, 21*, distance 110 lks.
