East, on random bet. secs. 23 and 26.

Var. 20°E.

40.00 Set temp. qr. sec. post.

76.45 Intersect right bank of Smith's River.

South 191 lks. from point W. of meander post on opposite bank. This close is probably owing to some error in one or more of the numerous triangulations upon which it depends, but as it embraces two secs. it is considered within the established limit.

80.25 Length of line.

S.88°38'W., on true line bet. secs. 23 and 26.

At point W. of meander post on left bank, the post in line of secs. 23 and 24, N. 8.52 chs., bears N.24°E.

Distance on line, 3.85 chs.

3.85 Leave Smith's River, set post, from which
