 37.00 Ridge, course NW and S.  
 40.00 Set qr. sec. post, from which  
     A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears N.61°E., 26 lks.  
     dist.  
     A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears S.74°E., 48 lks.  
     dist.  
 42.30 To left bank of the Umpqua River, set meander post,  
     from which  
     A maple, 18 ins. diam., bears S.20°E., 43 lks.  
     dist.  
 No trees near N. of line, raised monument of stones.  
 Land, same as last mile.

North, bet. secs. 27 and 28.

3.50 Enter marsh, course W.  
 4.40 To left bank of Umpqua River.  
 Set post, from which  
     A spruce, 12 ins. diam., bears S.25°W., 38 lks.  
     dist.  
     A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears S.33°E., 176 lks.  
     dist.  
 Mackey's House bears S.80°W.  
 Eylson's House bears N.67°W.  
 Across on Mackey's Island in line, Base E. 5.00 chs.  
 Angle, 25½°. Distance 10.47 chs.
