Land, mostly mountainous.
Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate.
Timber, spruce, fir and alder.
Undergrowth, Sallal and salmon berry.
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- East, on random bet. secs. 21 and 28.
- 1.42 Leave river.
- 40.00 Set temp. qr. sec. post.
- 80.60 Intersect sec. cor.
- West, on true line bet. secs. 21 and 28.
- 4.72 To shore of Grass Island.
Set post, drove charred stake, raised mound with trench
as per instructions.
Base, E. 4.72 chs. and S. 5.26 chs.
Angle opposite, 16*; distance, 13.61 chs.
- 18.33 To left bank of Umpqua River.
Set post, from which
An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears North, 4 lks. dist.
An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S.2*W., 4 lks. dist.
- 22.00 Ridge, course N and S.
- 38.00 Ridge, course N.
- 40.30 Set qr. sec. post, from which
A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S.70*W., 15 lks.
dist.
A hemlock, 50 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 38 lks.
dist.
- 65.00 Stream 6 lks. wide, course NW.
- 79.18 To left bank of Umpqua River.
Set meander post, from which
A spruce, 24 ins. diam., bears S.89*E., 406 lks.
dist.
A spruce, 48 ins. diam., bears N.89*E., 431 lks.
dist.
- 80.60 Dist. to sec. cor.
