CHAINS

Land, same as last mile.

November 4, 1857.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, thence West, on random line.

At 3 miles and 65 chs., intersect shore of the Pacific Ocean S. 393 lks. from a post established E. 2.26 chs. from the beginning of the course S. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 80.47 chs. noted in the survey of the Coast Meridian. Nov. 5, 1857. Hence the error in latitude is 10.5 chs. per mile, and the true course S. 89*15'E.

A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 6*E., 50 lks. dist.

Timber, spruce, hemlock and fir.

Undergrowth, sallal bushes.
