	West on random line bet. secs. 3 and 10. Va. $20\frac{1}{2}^*E.$
40.00	Set temp. qr sec. cor.
79.54	Intersect N end S line, 42 lks. North of cor. to secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, which is a post, 5 ins. diam., 4 ft. long, marked T 22 S S 3 on NE., R 4 W S 10 on SE., S 9 on SW., S 4 on NW face, from which A Fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.47*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 4 W S 3 B T. A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.11*E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 4 W S 10 B T. A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.42*W., 28 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 4 W S 9 B T. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.6*W., 94 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 4 W S 4 B T.
	Thence I run N.89*42'E., on true line bet. secs. 3 and 10. Ascend 30*
10.00	Descend 27*
34.50	Branch, 3 lks. wide, flows SE., ascend 20*
39.00	Enter dense vinemapple thicket.
39.77	Set post, 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12 ins. in ground for qr. sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.47*W., 55 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.54	Still ascend 27* The cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11. Land very rough, timber fir. Thick undergrowth of vinemapple and hazel, 79.54 chs.
