 A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 80 lks. dist.,
 marked T 21 S R 4 W S 33 B T.
 A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.41°E., 39 lks. dist.,
 marked T 22 S R 4 W S 5 B T.
 A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.11½°W., 45 lks. dist.,
 marked T 22 S R 4 W S 6 B T.
 A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.60°W., 58 lks. dist.,
 marked T 21 S R 4 W S 31 B T. *

- 48.60 Top of ridge, descend 10°
