A Redwood, 10 ins. diam., bears S.10\*E., 8 lks. dist., marked  
marked T 23 S R 4 W S 1 B T.

A Maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S.40\*W., 47 lks. dist.,  
marked T 23 S R 4 W S 2 B T.

53.00 Coast Fork Wagon Road, NE and SW., descend 19\*.

80.00 Set post, 6 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone in  
ground 12 ins., for cor. to secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36,  
marked T 22 S S 25 on NE., R 4 W S 36 on SE., S 35 on  
SW., S 26 on NW face, with 1 notch in E and S edges,
