Thick undergrowth, of hazel. 79.00 chs.

October 12, 1884

From the cor. to sec., 10, 11, 14 & 15, which is a post 4 ins. diam., in ground, marked T 22 S S 11 on NE R 5 W S 14 on SE S 15 on SW S 10 on NW face; from which,

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.10*W., 5 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 5 W S 10 B T.

A laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 59 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 5 W S 11 B T.

A laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 5 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 5 W S 14 B T.

A laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.35*W., 4 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 5 W S 15 B T.

I run North, bet. secs., 10 & 11.

Va.19*45'E.

Ascend 20*.

14.00 Top of hill descend 22*.

31.25 Branch 1 lk. wide flows East, ascend 25*.

35.50 Descend 15*.

40.00 Set post 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which,

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.65*W., 32 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

42.00 Branch 1 lk. wide flows E. ascend 15*.

61.00 Top of hill descend 10*.

80.00 Set post 6 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for cor. to secs., 2, 3, 10 & 11 marked T 22 S S 2 on NE R 5 W S 11 on SE S 10 on SW S 3 on NW face, with 2 notches in E. and 5 in S. edges; from which,
