80.80 Intersect N. & S. line 73 lks. north of cor. to secs.,  
3, 4, 9 & 10, which is a post 4 ins. in diam., in  
ground, marked T 22 S S 3 on NE R 5 W S 10 in SE S  
9 in SW S 4 in NW face; from which,

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.25\*E., 18 lks. dist.,  
marked T 22 S R 5 W S 3 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.38\*W., 46 lks. dist.,  
marked T 22 S R 5 W S 4 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.72\*W., 32 lks. dist.  
marked T 22 S R 5 W S 9 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.10\*E., 86 lks. dist.,  
marked T 22 S R 5 W S 10 B T.

Thence N.89\*29'E on true line bet. secs., 3 &amp; 10.

Descend 30\*.

17.00 Branch flows S. ascend 5\*.

30.00 Woodrings house bears SW.

33.00 Woodrings fence SE &amp; W.

40.40 Set post 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone  
12 ins. in ground for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S on N.  
face; from which,

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.56\*W., 72 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.51 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 104 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  S B T.

Descend 10\*.

72.00 Branch 2 lks. wide flows S.
