	North, on random line bet. secs. 2 & 3. Va.20*E.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.00	Intersect North bdy. of township 100 lks. East of cor. to secs., 34, 35, 2 & 3. which is a post 4 ins. diam., in ground marked T 21 S S 35 on NE R 5 W S 2 on SE T 22 S S 3 on SW S 34 in NW face; from which, A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.33*E., 26 lks. dist., marked T 22 S R 5 W S 2 B T. A dogwood, 6 ins. diam., bears S.68*W., 26 lks. dist. marked T 22 S R 5 W S 3 B T. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.54*W., 12 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 5 W S 34 B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.20*E., 17 lks. dist., marked T 21 S R 5 W S 35 B T. Thence, S.43'E on true line bet. secs., 2 & 3.

38.50	Cross fence E & W.
39.00	Set post 4 ins. diam., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face; from which, A oak, 20 ins. diam., bears S.49*W., 203 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.5-3/4*E., 360 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.00	Ascend gradually 5*. The cor. to secs., 2, 3, 10 & 11. Land, nearly level. Soil, 2nd. rate. Timber, fir,.
