

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

CHAINS

26, 27, 34 and 35, above described, which I reestablish, at same point, as follows

Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26 and 35, mkd. T 22 S S 26 on NE., and R 6 W S 35 on SE faces; with 2 notches on E and 1 notch on S. edges; from which

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.48*E., 3 lks. dist. mkd. T 22 S R 6 W S 26 B T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.35*E., 23 lks. dist. mkd. T 22 S R 6 W S 35 B T.

At point of intersection, 377 lks. N. of this cor, I

Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 27, and 34 mkd. C C T 22 S R 6 W on W., S 27 on N., and S 34 on S faces; with 1 groove on S. face, from which

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.36*W., 25 lks. dist. mkd. T 22 S R 6 W S 34 B T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 39 lks. dist. mkd. T 22 S R 6 W S 27 B T.

This cor. is on N. slope of ridge, about 50 ft. below top. Land, mountainous and rolling.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Timber, Fir, cedar, hemlock, maple, madrona, dogwood, chinquin and ash.

Dense undergrowth of hazel ocean spray, vine maple hemlock and fir.

Mountainous land, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 79.95 chs.

South, on a true line, bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Mag. decl. 20*30'E.

1.75 Top of spur, slopes NE., 25 ft. above sec. cor. descend.

2.70 Ravine, course NE., 50 ft. below top of last spur, ascend spur.
