	N.89*47'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 19 and 30. Descend.
3.28	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N, 25 ft. below sec. cor; ascend spur.
4.00	Top of spur, slopes N. 25 ft. above last creek; descend.
6.24	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.70*W., 50 ft. below top of spur, last noted; ascend.
9.70	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.60*W., 50 ft. above last creek.
38.26	Set a dogwood post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face, from which A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N87*E., 157 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 128 lks. dist. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. This cor. is on the westerly slope of spur, about 400 ft. above Creek.
44.50	Top of spur slopes N., 50 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; descend.
55.00	Ravine, course N. 375 ft. below top of spur last noted; ascend spur.
57.75	Top of spur, slopes N. 35 ft. above last ravine; descend.
60.75	Ravine, course N. 40 ft. below top of last spur; ascend spur.
67.75	Top of spur, slopes N. 120 ft. above last ravine; descend.
74.75	Ravine, course N, 100 ft. below top of last spur; ascend spur.
76.75	Top of spur, slopes N. 50 ft. above last ravine; descend.
78.26	The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, 25 ft. below top of spur. Land, mountainous. Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate. Timber, scattering fir, cedar, hemlock, maple, madrona, dogwood and chincapin. dense undergrowth of thimble-berry, hazel, ocean-spray, mountain balm, salal-berry and poison oak.
