4.46	Right bank of Elk creek, measured North 130 lks. for a base, from which signal in line on opposite bank bears S.65*W., distance over, 278 lks.
7.24	Left bank of Elk.
8.75	Trail, course S.
16.00	Elk trail.
16.40	Stream, 2 lks. wide, course SW.
20.00	Enter oak openings.
39.95	Set $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. post, from which A b. oak, 48 ins. diam., bears N.13*E., 32 lks. dist. A b. oak, 30 ins. diam., bears S.83*E., 97 lks. dist.
40.00	Enter prairie.
67.50	Top of ridge and enter brush.
79.90	To sec. cor. Land, hilly. Soil, 2d rate. Timber, fir and oak. Undergrowth, oak and hazel.

80.00	Set post cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, from which A w. oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.37*E., 217 lks. dist. Raised mound with trench, as per instructions. Land, mountainous; soil, 2d rate. Timber, oak. Undergrowth, oak and hazel.
