 Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Madrona, and Chinquapin.
 Dense undergrowth of Vine maple, Hazel, Thimble-berry,
 and Fir.
 Mountainous land, heavily timbered or covered with
 dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

At the Cor. of Secs. 25, 26, 36 and 35; thence I run
 East, on a true line, bet. Secs. 25 and 36.

Mag. decl. 20°30'E.

Descend.

4.25 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE., 50 ft. below Sec. Cor.;
 foot of descent; thence across creek bottom.

26.70 Wagon road, bears N. and S.

26.90 Brush Creek, 25 lks. wide, course N.; begin ascent.

40.00 Set a Sandstone, 12x10x10 ins., 8 ins. in the ground,
 for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; from which
 An Alder, 6 ins. diam., bears N.59°E., 35 lks. dist.
 mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.27°W., 62 lks. dist.
 mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

This Qr. Sec. Cor., is on the steep NW. slope of mountain,
 about 75 ft. above Brush Creek.

40.20 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.80°W.

68.00 Top of ridge, bears NE and SW., 400 ft. above Qr. Sec. Cor.;
 descend.

72.74 Intersect West Bdy. of T 22 S., R 6 W., 470 lks. S. of
 the Cor. of Secs. 30 and 31, which I established
 November 25, 1897.

At point of intersection, I

Set a Madrona post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in
 the ground, for closing cor. of Secs. 25 and 36, mkd.
 C C T 22 S R 7 W., on W., S 25 on N., and S 36 on S.
 faces; with 1 groove on the S. and 5 grooves on N. faces;
