- 8.20 Road to Scottsburg.
- 9.20 Stream, 1 lk. wide, course SE.
- 10.70 Fence, course SW. Enter field.
- 25.67 Leave field; set meander post on right bank of the Umpqua River, from which
 A w oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.43°W. 53 lks. dist.
 Made trench as per instructions. Measured base S.57½°W. 600 lks. A tree in line near left bank bears S.43°E. Hence 864 to tree which is 71 lks. S. of River. 793 is the width of River.
- 33.60 Set meander post on left bank of Umpqua River, from which
 A cottonwood, 20 ins. diam., bears N.50°E. 15 lks. dist.
 A maple, 4 ins. diam., bears S.86°W. 19 lks. dist.
- 34.50 Enter timber, course SW.
- 40.00 Set ¼ sec. post, from which
 An ash, 15 ins. diam., bears N.75°E. 105 lks. dist.
 An ash, 18 ins. diam., bears N.87°W. 55 lks. dist.
 Land, hilly, mostly prairie.
 The remaining portion of this township line is totally unfit for cultivation and so precipitous both North & South of this half mile as to be inaccessible to survey. Hence T. 22 S., R. 9 W. is also surveyed by running the meanders of the Umpqua River and such section lines as appear by the traverse courses to be practicable in all cases establishing the meander posts at their proper places as shown in the field notes of the subdivisions.
