- 55.00 Ed. Griffin's house, bears S.36*E.
- 57.86 Road, course NW.
- 69.70 House, bears West.
- 73.70 Enter timber.
- 75.58 Intersect left bank of Umpqua River & set meander & witness post, from which
- A crab apple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.80*E. 28 lks. dist.
- A W. oak, 15 ins. diam., bears S.62*W. 235 lks. dist.
- Measured West 168 lks. for a base, from which signal in line on opposite bank bears N.13 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E. Distance across 700 lks.
