- 40.00 Set  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. post, deposited charred stake, raised mound with trench & pits as per instructions.
- 44.92 Intersect left bank of Umpqua & set meander post, from which  
 A willow, 5 ins. diam., bears S.10°E. 13 lks. dist.  
 An ash, 8 ins. diam., bears N.33°E. 15 lks. dist.  
 Crossed in line & measured North 250 lks. for a base from which meander post bears S.72°W. dist. 770 lks.
- 52.22 Set meander post on right bank, from which  
 An ash, 5 ins. diam., bears North 4 lks. dist.  
 An ash, 24 ins. diam., bears S.72°E. 32 lks. dist.
- 53.00 Road to Scottsburg cut in rocky bluff impossible to ascend.  
 Land, West of river, level prairie.  
 Soil, 1st rate.
