40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 80.00 Find the timber hereabouts fell in all directions. Rails made and hauled off but can find no trace of old lines or cor. I mark a fir, 10 ins. diam., without witness trees for cor. and establish line  
 North on true line.  
 40.00 Marked a fir, 24 ins. diam., for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 55.00 Top of ridge, course NE. & SW.  
 80.00 To sec. cor.  
 Land, South of ridge, sloping.  
 Soil, 2nd rate.  
 North of ridge, hilly, 3rd rate.  
 Timber, young fir, good.  
 Underbrush, same with hazel, dogwood & alder.

East, from cor. to Secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18.  
 On a random line bet. Secs. 8 & 17.  
 Var. 20°E.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 80.45 Intersect line 60 lks. South of cor.  
 South, 89°34' West on true line.  
 30.00 Top of ridge, course NE. & SW. +600  
 40.22 Marked a fir, 5 ins. diam. on steep hillside for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. No trees near.  
 66.00 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW. -200  
 80.45 To sec. cor.  
 Land, rolling, 2nd rate.  
 Timber, same as preceding line.
