A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.84\*E. 41 lks. dist.

A W. oak, 15 ins. diam., bears S.83\*W. 61 lks. dist.

80.00 Set maple post for the cor. to Secs. 9, 10, 15 & 16,  
from which

A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears N.80\*E. dist. 74 lks.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.38\*E. dist. 124 lks.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.89\*W. dist. 57 lks.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.40\*W. dist. 154 lks.
