North, on true line bet. Secs. 4 & 3.

Var. 19*E.

3.00 Enter field.

11.00 Shed, east 100 lks.

21.00 Leave field.

40.00 Set fir post for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.68*E. 166 lks. dist.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.62*W. 182 lks. dist.

81.84 Intersect North bdy. of Tp. 14.00 chs. West of the established cor. to Secs. 33 & 34.

Set fir post for the cor. to Secs. 3 & 4, from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.20*E. 26 lks. dist.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.70*W. 38 lks. dist.

Land, mountainous, 2nd rate.

Timber, chiefly fir & cedar.

West, on a true line bet. Secs. 4 & 9.

Var. 19*E.

2.00 Enter field.

4.50 Leave same, begin descent.

20.00 County road, course N. & S.

20.50 Enter field & valley.

25.50 Pond, 1 ch. wide.

29.50 Left bank of Umpqua river.

Set meander post bet. Secs. 4 & 9, from which

An oak, 30 ins. diam., bears S.5*E. 146 lks. dist.

A hemlock, 48 ins. diam., bears N.35*W. 59 lks. dist.

Land, hilly, 2nd rate. 1st rate in valley.

Oak grubs outside of field.

Beginning at meander cor. bet. Secs. 4 & 9, I run down the left bank of river in Sec. 4.
