80.94	To sec. cor. Land, North part 1st class, nearly level. South part, mountainous, 3rd rate. Timber, chiefly fir, cedar, hemlock, oak & maple. March 3, 1881

33.00	Stream, 2 lks. course E.
35.30	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course E.
