General Description

The lands of this fractional Township are not varied from those of adjoining townships. The lands included in this survey contain but little first class agricultural land, they chiefly in Secs. 9, 10 & 11.

The mountains are all covered with fine forests of fir, cedar, hemlock, laurel and oak, while maple and ash are flourishing along the river and small creeks.

There are one settlement in Sec. 2, one in 3, two in 4, one in 9, four in 10 and one in Sec. 12.
