CHAINS

Beginning at the SW. cor. to Tp. 22 S., R. 8 W., I run  
 West, along N. Bdy. Sec. 6.

Var. 20\*25'E.

Ascend over N. slope through timber.

4.25 Top of a ridge, course N. about 100 ft. above cor. and  
 descend.

8.75 The NW. cor. to Tp. 23 S., R. 8 W.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, and hemlock.

Some underbrush of same and hazel, 8.75 chs.

Resurvey of the West Bdy. T. 22 S., R. 8 W.  
 as surveyed by Elmer O. Worrick, Deputy Surveyor  
 under Contract No. 632, dated April. 28, 1894.

Commenced at the cor. to Secs. 1, 12, 6 and 7, which I  
 reestablish as follows:

Set fir post, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
 ground, marked T. 22 S. S 6 on the NE., R 8 W S 7 on  
 the SE., R 9 W S 12 on the SW., and S 1 on the NW.  
 faces with 5 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the W. edges  
 from which

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.32\*E. 24 lks. dist.  
 marked T 22 S R 8 W S 6 B T.

A fir (stump), 20 ins. diam., bears S.64\*E. 47 lks.  
 dist., marks grown over.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.42\*W. 42 lks. dist.  
 marks grown over.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.45\*W. 6 lks. dist.  
 marked T 22 S R 9 W S 1 B T.

Practically agreeing with notes furnished me by the U. S.  
 Surveyor General.

Thence I run
