September 3, 1874.

East, on true line, between secs. 8 and 17.

Va. 19°E.

3.00 Begin steep ascent.

18.00 Top of spur, Course N.

39.50 Intersect river.

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Set Ash post, 40 ins. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in ground, for the meander post, from which,

An Alder, 10 ins, diam., bears S.65°E., 41 lks. dist.

An Alder, 6 ins., diam., bears S.40°W., 30 lks. dist.

Across river, base South 2.00 chs.

Angle opposite, 18°. Across 6.17 chs.

45.67 To right bank of river.

Land, mountainous, second rate.

Timber, principally Fir, second rate.
