A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.86°W., 29 lks. dist. Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 5 B. T.  Land, mountainous. 53.00 chs.  Soil, second rate.  Timber, Fir and scattering Oak .  Undergrowth of Hazel, Oak, Fir, vine-Maple, Mountain Balm, and Arrow wood. 53.00 chs.  October 18, 1894.
