

Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.58*W., 105 lks. dist.

Marked T. 21 S., R. 9 W., S. 32 B. T.

I destroyed marks on posts and B. T. on South.

I set sand stone 14 x 12 x 6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground at point of intersection for closing corner to sec. 4 and 5, marked C. C. on the S., 4 grooves on the E., and 2 grooves on the W. side, from which,

A Fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.71*30*E., 103 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 4 B. T.

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.52*W., 175 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 5 B. T.

A Fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.20*30*E., 42 lks. dist.

Marked C. C. T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 4 and 5 B. T.

Land, mountainous, 74.23 chs.

Soil, second and third rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Alder, Chinquapin, and Wild Cherry.

Undergrowth, dense Salalberry, Rhododendron, Hazel, Huckleberry, Thimbleberry, Arrow wood, vine-Maple, and Alder. 74.23 chs.

October 19, 1894.

Commenced at the corner to secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, which is a post, 4 ins. square, 30 ins. above ground, marked T. 22 S., S. 8, on the NE., R. 9 W., S. 17 on the SE. S. 18 on the SW. and S. 1, on the NW., faces with 4 notches on the S., and 5 notches on the E. edge, from which,

A W. Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.22*E., 19 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 8 B. T.

A Fir, 70 ins. diam., bears S.65*E., 46 lks. dist.

Marked T. 22 S., R. 9 W., S. 17 B. T.
