

## Subdivisions of T. 22 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

to left bank of river, 33.30 makes

41.35 To margin of water on right bank of river.

Thence, I run,

North,

42.40 To top of bank of river.

Set at this point, a Fir post, 5 feet long, 4 ins. square,  
24 ins. in the ground for corner to fractional secs.7 and 8, marked M C T 22 S R 9 W on the S., S 8 on the  
E., and S 7 on the W., faces, from which

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.14\*30'E., 40 lks. dist.

Marked M C T 22 S R 9 W S 8 B T.

A Dogwood, 4 ins. diam., bears N.79\*W., 24 lks. dist.

Marked M C T 22 S R 9 W S 7 B T.

Note: I made diligent search on both banks of the river  
for the meander corners, but could not find any trace  
of them, the floods had destroyed them.

Thence, I run,

North, 0\*04'W., between secs. 7 and 8.

The river runs S.65\*W.

Va. 20\*E.

47.60 Road to Scottsburg, Course N.65\*E., S.65\*W.

57.50 Ascend hill.

80.00 Set Fir post, 4½ feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in  
the ground for corner to secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, marked  
T 22 S S 5 on the NE., R 9 W S 8 on the SE., S 7 on the  
SW., and S 6 on the NW., faces with 5 notches on the  
S. and E edges, from which

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.59\*15'E., 66 lks. dist.

Marked T 22 S R 9 W S 5 B T.

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.59\*30'E., 48 lks. dist.

Marked T 22 S R 9 W S 8 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.56\*W., 57 lks. dist.
